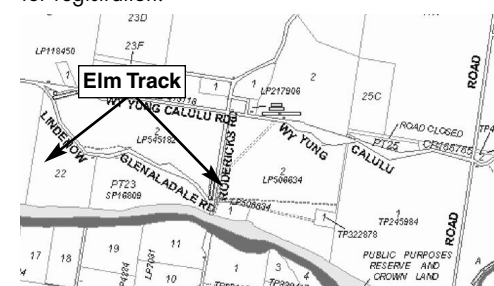
## Community Christmas Events
